### Form of Declaration for obtaining a Widow's Army Pension.

State of *New York, City and* }  
County of *New York* } ss.

On this *30<sup>th</sup>* day of *September* A. D., one thousand eight hundred and sixty *two*, personally appeared before me *Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas for the City and County of New York*  
*Henra Krieger* a resident of *New York* in the county of *New York* and state of *New York*, aged *45* years, who, being first duly sworn according to law, doth on her oath make the following declaration, in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress, approved July 14, 1862: That she is the widow of *Friedrich Krieger* who was a *Corporal* in company *B* commanded by *Capt. F. Seale* in the *1<sup>st</sup>* regiment of *Sherel's New York Engineers* in the war of 1861, who on or about the *10<sup>th</sup>* day of *September* 1862 at *Holton Head* came to his death by reason of: *fever, age 42 years*

She further declares that she was married to the said *Friedrich Krieger* on the *10<sup>th</sup>* day of *January* in the year 18*45*; that her husband, the aforesaid *Friedrich Krieger* died on the day above mentioned, and that she has remained a widow ever since that period, *has one child, Helena, 12 years of age, who resides with her, has no marriage certificate.*

as will more fully appear by reference to the proof hereto annexed. She also declares that she has not in any manner been engaged in, or aided or abetted the rebellion in the United States.

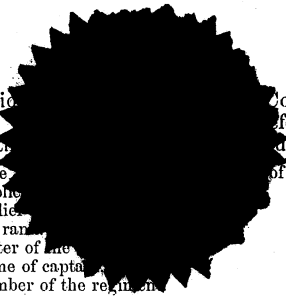
Also personally appeared *Carl Krieger* and *Ludwig Krieger* residents of *N.Y.C. & Fort Lee* in the state of *New York* persons whom I certify to be respectable, and entitled to credit, and who being by me duly sworn, say that they were present and saw *Henra Krieger sign her name* to the foregoing declaration; and they further swear that they have every reason to believe, from the appearance of the applicant and their acquaintance with her, that she is the identical person she represents herself to be; and they further state *she is of good moral character, that she has one child, age 12 years and that said child resides with her. That they were present at the marriage* that they have no interest in the prosecution of this claim.

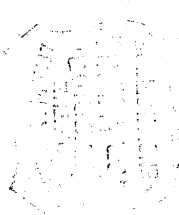
